Talent from lower socio-economic backgrounds takes 16% more time to progress...



Men from higher socio-economic backgrounds are

3.4x

more likely to reach senior roles than women from lower socio-economic backgrounds.

50% firms

Have no ethnic minority leaders from lower socio-economic backgrounds at senior level.
